## **ANÁLISIS ARTÍSTICO**

There are various differences between this preparatory sketch and the final print *This* too. The most significant change can be seen on the right-hand side of the drawing, which shows a structure that might be a building – perhaps a church or monastery – from which the monks are fleeing in panic. This building has been omitted from the final print, which shows a mountain in its place. Moreover, in the drawing, the habits of the monks depicted in the foreground are lifted up, a detail Goya also omitted in the final print and which might give a satirical edge to the image.
